SUMMARY PROTECTION ORDER

Pursuant to sections 126 and 259 of the *Health Professions and Occupations Act* [SBC 2022] c.43 and on the direction of a panel of the Investigation Committee, the **Registrar orders that:**

Madison Barnett's licence to practice nursing is suspended.

Under the *Health Professions and Occupations Act*, Summary Protection Orders ("SPO") are an interim risk management tool. Their purpose is to manage risk during an investigation. At the time an SPO is made, the concerns about a nurse or midwife's professional practice or capacity to practice have not been fully investigated and no finding of misconduct or impaired capacity has been made. An SPO can impose limits or conditions on a nurse or midwife's practice or suspend their license.
